

# CPD Requirements

## Non-compliance Timeline

CPD REQUIREMENTS NOT MET BY DUE DATE

ON NOTICE

6 MONTHS to correct CPD Credits

Name flagged for CPD non-compliance

NO ACTION by CCPA

UNDER SUSPENSION

6 MONTHS to correct CPD Credits

Name removed from public CCPA list

NO ACTION by CCPA

NON-COMPLIANT

90 DAYS/ 3 MONTHS to submit plan

Lose privilege to use CCPA certification designation

NO ACTION by CCPA

RE-WRITE PACCC ENTRY TO PRACTICE PA CERT EXAM

First attempt within 1 year of non-compliance status

Can be attempted up to 3 years after non-compliance status

Maximum 3 attempts

OR

REQUEST SUBMITTED BY NON-COMPLIANT PA TO REQUEST RE-INSTATEMENT

REQUEST FOR RE-INSTATEMENT

PA submits request for re-instatement

PA submits required documents as requested by PACCC (i.e., proof of maintenance of competence, letters of reference medical directives etc.

PACCC reviews and renders decision either re-instates or PA must re-write exam (NOTE – only 1 re-instatement is permissible)
